

ALDRIDGE RUNNING CLUB
ALLOCATION OF LONDON MARATHON 'CLUB' PLACES

Aldridge Running Club will allocate 'Club' places, receives from UKA, for the London marathon as follows:

1. A member whose entry is rejected via the London marathon ballot entry system for three consecutive years or more will be entitled to receive a Club place.
2. In the event that the number of members fulfilling the criteria stated in 1. above exceeds the quota of Club places received from UKA, a draw will be held to determine the recipients.
On such occasions priority will be given to members who have not ran the London marathon previously.
3. In circumstances where there are more Club places available than members meeting the criteria stated in 1. above, a draw will be held to determine the recipients.
On such occasions priority will be given to members who have been rejected via the London marathon ballot entry system for two consecutive years.
4. On any occasion where a draw will be required to determine the recipients, members will be informed of the date of the draw on the first Tuesday evening in October.
5. The minimum criteria for a member to be eligible for a Club place shall be that they have been rejected through the London marathon ballot entry system and have been a first claim member of ARC for twelve months or more.
6. A member who wishes to apply for a Club place must provide a copy of their official 'rejection' letter to ARC's London marathon co-ordinator.
A copy of the 'Not this time' marathon magazine is not suitable proof of rejection.
7. A member receiving a Club place must enter the marathon in their own name.
8. In the unlikely event that a member, having received a Club place, decides not to enter the marathon, the member must inform ARC's London marathon co-ordinator; in such circumstances the committee will determine how the place is to be reallocated.
9. A member receiving a Club place must run the marathon in a Club vest/Club colours.
10. A member who receives a Club place for the marathon will be ineligible for another Club place for five year's.
